Responding to Situations in Clinical Courses

What to do when a STUDENT :	STUDENT should:
Identifies potential symptoms of COVID-19	 Report symptoms to field placement site and COVID-19 liaison Contact UHS or primary care provider for follow-up Convey instructions from UHS or primary care provider to field placement site and COVID-19 liaison and carries out instructions from UHS or primary care provider
Runs out of/loss of PPE (e.g., loses cloth mask or site-specific mask/face shield)	Contact field placement site and COVID-19 liaison to obtain more PPE (or receive instructions on how to obtain more PPE) and follows through with plan to obtain missing PPE
Identification of site issues (e.g., practices that are putting student at increased risk or increased cases of COVID-19)	Contact COVID-19 liaison to report issues and follows through with decisions from program/department/school regarding continuation of field placement or reassignment to alternate site/experience

What to do when a FIELD PLACEMENT SITE:	FIEID SITE should:
Identifies student issue (e.g., not completing training, non-adherence to site PPE/safety policy)	Contact COVID-19 liaison to report specific issue(s) and collaborates on report and subsequent recommendations from program/department/school COVID-19 official/committee
Identifies an increase in COVID-19 cases at the field placement site	Contact COVID-19 liaison to report change in cases and collaborates with liaison on any necessary modifications to placement that will affect students

What to do when PROGRAM / DEPT / SCHOOL :	PROGRAM / DEPARTMENT / SCHOOL should:
Identifies a student with presumptive or positive COVID-19 diagnosis	 Provide resources available during quarantine period Contact field placement site to report student illness Contact other field placement course professor and work with professor on plan to make-up hours lost during quarantine/illness
Identifies a faculty supervisor (for clinical groups) with presumptive or positive COVID-19 diagnosis	 Provide resources available during quarantine period Contact field placement site to report faculty illness and/or student exposure Initiate plan for make-up of hours as outlined in specific program/department/school guidelines/policy Contact all students in clinical group to report exposure and outline plan for UHS/primary care provider follow-up
Identifies field site issue (e.g., increased number of COVID-19 presumptive or positive cases, increased student risk d/t non-adherence to safety measures)	 Contact students currently working in the field placement site with directions to cease placement hours until site issue has been resolved Contact faculty supervisor in the case of a clinical group with directions to cease placement hours until site issue has been resolved Provide relevant directions to students and faculty regarding need for testing/quarantine/provider follow-up Works/collaborates with field site official to resolve issue
